

CAMPSITE NOTES

(FOR GROUPS CAMPING AND USING THE CAMP BUILDING).

Welcome to Thornbridge Outdoors. If you have not visited the Centre before please take time to become familiar with both the building and the grounds.

There is an INFORMATION FOLDER in the dining room containing emergency telephone numbers, site plan and other useful information. A separate folder contains details of local doctors and hospitals.

ACCESS / PARKING

Access to the campsite is gained via the main car park. Vehicles are not allowed on the camp site (except with prior permission).

TOILETS / SHOWERS

Toilet and shower facilities are located at the end of the 'Camp' building. Please note that the toilets are also used by other visiting groups.

WHERE TO CAMP?

Please camp in front of the 'Camp' building in between the two 'fire points'.

WATER SUPPLY / DISH WASHING

As well as sinks and a dishwasher inside the Camp kitchen, there is also hot / cold water available at the end of the 'Camp' building.

LOW ROPES / BOULDER / HIGH ROPES / SKY ROPES

Please note that the Low Ropes / High Ropes / Boulder/Sky Ropes must only be used when supervised by an approved member of staff.

FIRE

We strongly recommend that you talk through in detail what to do in the event of a fire. There are two 'fire points' on the campsite both equipped with fire extinguishers. The fire point nearest to the campers' block is fitted with a bell on the back of it. The person discovering a fire should activate this. The Fire Assembly Point is in the car park (look for a green Fire Assembly Point sign on a fir tree beyond the minibus parking area). Should it be necessary to call the fire brigade your location is: Thornbridge Outdoors, Great Longstone, Derbyshire, DE45 1NY (**GRID REFERENCE: 196 710**)

Please note: No fires may be lit on the campsite.

No naked flames or stoves should be allowed in tents. Staff should supervise all cooking.

ADDRESS LIST

Our 'Camp name and address list' can be found in the forms section of the website for you to download and enter group names and addresses in preparation for your visit.

If you are a weekend group you will need to put it in the envelope on the clip on the office door on the first evening of your stay.

If you are a weekday group please hand it to reception on arrival.

DOGS

Please note that **NO DOGS** are allowed on-site.

DRYING ROOM

The Drying Room is just inside the main door of the Camp building. This room is permanently heated to help you recycle wet clothing quickly!

TUMBLE DRYER

There is a tumble dryer in the garage which you can use; you will need a supply of 20p pieces. The garage has a large sliding green door facing 'The Farm'. Entry is through the side door.

LITTER

Large green wheelie bins are located in the main car park. If you move one of these bins nearer the campsite area, please return it to the car park on departure. Please ensure that the site is kept clean and tidy during your stay.

Recycling bins should be emptied into the named wheelie bins in the car park. Please wash the recycling bins before replacing them in the kitchen.

STORES

Please ensure that everything is booked out and recorded back as you will be responsible for any losses at the end of your stay. Our signing in/out sheet for equipment can be found in the 'forms' section of the website for you to download and enter group names in preparation for your visit.

Boots should be cleaned (underneath as well!) taking care not to get the insides wet and then left in pairs on the stores counter, or in the drying room with the green door, at the end of the stores building if they get accidentally wet inside!

OTHER USERS

There is likely to be other groups at Thornbridge during your stay. Please be considerate when pitching your tents and keep noise to a minimum at night time.

LOST PROPERTY

Before you leave, please do a final check round to make sure that no-one has left anything.

EVALUATION FORM

On departure, please fill in the evaluation form and leave it in the 'Camp folder'.

CLEANING

In order to clean and prepare the unit for the next group, it is essential that departing groups complete the tasks on the checklist provided in your 'Camp folder'. Basic cleaning equipment is provided.
