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# Xmas Tree Towers!

Your challenge is to build a tower shaped like a Christmas tree from your recycling and see if you can make it as tall as a real Christmas tree!

This game can be played indoors or outdoors. You can play individually, compete against household members, or work together in a team.

## 5 KEY RULES

- 1** No more than 4 of any item can be used (e.g. 4 milk bottles, 4 cereal boxes, 4 drinks cans).
- 2** Only use clean items from your own recycling inside the house (don't raid the bins... who knows what's in there!).
- 3** No breakable things (e.g. glass) or sharp things (e.g. tins).
- 4** Your Recycling Tower must be freestanding. This means it can't be held up by anyone or rested against anything - it has to stand up.
- 5** You aren't allowed to stick or tape anything together, but you can cut things up (with adult permission and supervision).

## AIM

To build as tall a **freestanding** tower out of recycling as possible.

It must stay up for **5 seconds** minimum.

Once you have built it, see if you can accurately **measure it**.

How **tall** is your Recycling Tower?





When you've finished, remember to wash your hands!

Your structure needs to be:  
Tall, Solid and Stable.
